

Oktoberfest Frequently Asked Questions

Transportation

- FREE shuttles on Friday to and from the fairgrounds to the Golden Keg Procession/Royalty announcements at the Leinenkugel's Barn (approximately from 11 am to 1 pm)
- *Loopy's will provide FREE shuttles for event attendees within 15 miles of the event grounds – guests should call 715-723-5667 to schedule a pick up.*
- Refer to local cab companies for transportation to and from grounds

Parking

- New this year - parking is FREE.
- VIP Parking (Freund Parking) isn't sold at the event. Must be purchased in package before event.
- Motor coaches are welcome. Enter through EAST GATE. Regular admission fees apply to motor coach guests. Driver is FREE. Handicapped parking is available at the EAST GATE.

Admissions

- Lost wristbands will not be replaced.
- Wristbands provide you with the flexibility to enter and exit the event throughout the day or weekend, based on the type of wristband you have.
- Tickets are not sold for individual shows, your admission wristband gets you access to all band performances.

Online Purchases

- Wristband purchases bought online can be picked up at the Chippewa Falls Area Chamber of Commerce through Sept. 14. On Sept. 15 & 16, the wristbands will be at the Will Call window, near the main entrance.
- Merchandise purchased online must be collected from the Chippewa Falls Area Chamber of Commerce before September 14. Any merchandise not collected by this date will be available for pickup at the Chippewa Falls Area Chamber of Commerce starting September 18.

Pets/Solicitation/bikes, etc.

- No Pets on the grounds.
- Service animals ARE allowed.
- No biking, roller blading, recreational scooters within the event grounds – need to be parked at gates.
- No political solicitation allowed.
- No weapons on grounds.

Camping

- No camping open for the general public. Just for vendors or committee members. Refer to [Go Chippewa Visitor Guide](#) for camping and hotel information.

Competitions

- No sign up needed for Sauerkraut eating contest – just show up
- Sign up for Stein Holding and Keg Rolling at Information Booth.
